NOTES AND QUOTES

Early injury indications for Tampa Bay are a dislocated elbow to David Logan. The injury is serious enough that he will miss more time but the extent of how much time he'll miss is still unknown. He has a current streak of 87 consecutive regular season starts that is a Buc record. STEVE YOUNG sustained a minor concussion and was not available for any postgame quotes. The seriousness of his injury is not yet entirely known. JERRY BELL fractured hand and will miss some time.

First year wide receiver ED SCOTT tied a Buc preseason record with eight receptions (58 yards). Ricky Bell also had eight receptions against Miami on August 6, 1977.

The Bucs career preseason record is now even at 23-23. They are 4-7 in preseason openers.

HEAD COACH LEEMAN BENNETT will be available to the press at 5 p.m. Sunday. There will be no Buc practice Monday and no press session scheduled for Bennett.

The rain delay tonight was officially 45 minutes. The only previous rain delay for a Bucs game in Tampa Stadium came against Atlanta in 1978. LEEMAN BENNETT was the head coach at Atlanta at that time. That game was September 24, 1978. The delay in that game was approximately 30 minutes.

FRANK MIDDLETON's six-yard touchdown run came on his first ever run in a Buc uniform.

QUOTES

COACH STALLINGS: "I felt our defense played well. The extra preseason game helped us. We had a few turnovers and got to their quarterback. Our offense sputtered some. We had a hard time standing up but so did they. I was pleased with our kicking game. (Danny) Miller kicked well and so did John Lee. I'm afraid we won't have the luxury of keeping two kickers."

NIKO NOGA "I just saw the quarterback throw the ball. I guess I just reacted faster. My last interception was in college. That's it."

DAVID GALLOWAY "Steve Young is so darned fast you can immediately see that 4.5 speed. Maybe he ought to change to running back."

(Advantage with extra game?): "The mistakes we made last week would have been made this week."

O.J. ANDERSON "This week I didn't feel like I contributed enough and I'm really not that satisfied. Our main concern tonight was to shut down Tampa Bay's potent offense with Wilder and Giles. If we continue to improve each week we will be right where we need to be for the start of the season."

LIONEL WASHINGTON "Tonight everybody worked together. We have a lot of talent on this team. When you play hard you're gonna get the breaks. Tonight we played hard."

LEEMAN BENNETT "I was surprised somewhat by the play tonight. I thought we would play better tonight especially offensively. And I thought we would move the ball better than we did. In this ballgame, whether the extra game helped them that much or not I don't know. But it did appear to help them a great deal or at least they seemed much more aware than our team."

(DEFENSE) "The defense did a good job and we didn't give up a touchdown. They did a good job on goal line and short yardage situations."

(OFFENSE) "The play of Alan Risher in the second half was pretty good."

(STEVE YOUNG) "Young ran well. I thought he took a cheap shot on the sideline when they (Cardinals) enalized him."
