COLTS - BUCS COACHES QUOTES

HEAD COACH RON MEYER - "The most encouraging thing from a coaches standpoint is that there were no injuries on either side. I was pleased with the production of our offense. And I think our defensive backs, both first and second units, played well."

"The Bucs are better than a year ago, and they will be better this year as it goes along."

"I like to see our team win, even though it's preseason, but to just reinforce the positive things we're out to get."

HEAD COACH RAY PERKINS - "The defense needs to play much tougher and much more aggressive and the offense had some malfunctions. We had poor pass protection, except on third down when they were in the nickle defense. We had a couple of missed throws and a few dropped balls."

"We played a lot of people to give them an opportunity. Individually, we did some good things on both sides of the football, but I'm disappointed overall."

"We were better than this point last year (talking about Wilder and D. Smith). WE ran better and I am please with some aspects of the running game."

"He was below par (on Testaverde). He missed a few throws and had an interception, but that doesn't bother me. (On Ferguson) He played like a 16-year veteran."

BUCS

DON SMITH - "It was a great feeling being back. First I was excited and nervous, but I was still glad to be back. I was pleased with my performance, but I know there is room for improvment. The one aspect I need to work on is my blocking."

KERRY GOODE - "I felt good and comfortable. I really wanted to get a lot of time this game. But I had to keep in mind that this is just another game. Things are much quicker and your reaction time has to be much quicker in the NFL."

CLAY WHITEHURST - "It was great to play on the same field where I ended my college career (Alabama vs. Michigan in last year's Hall of Fame Bowl) and opened my procareer. I was happy with my performance, but there are plenty of things to be correcte But it was good to get my feet wet."

VINNY TESTAVERDE - "Mentally I was there, but physically I stunk. WE got off to a great start with the running game. It definitely helps to work with the same guys all the time, but the coaches need to see a lot of people and the other team is doing the same thing. It just seemed like slow motion tonight, we just need to put it all together. If I could of played longer, I would of gotten better."

COLTS

ERIC DICKERSON - "I got a couple of hits and got out. He (Meyer) said about 10 to 12 plays and that would be it. I feel I am in good shape. (On the TD) It was an off tackle play. I made the cot to the outside and went right in."

MIKE PRIOR - 'When you have the team working together, good things always happen. (On the in INT.) Two guys were coming down the seam, and I saw him (TEstaverde) looking at him and lofted it up and I got it. (Any surprises on the Bucs offense) I didn't think so, nothing that we didn't expect in the first preseason game.

JACK TRUDEAU - "I still want to be starting QB, I never will be happy unless I'm the starting quarterback. It was good to get out there and play against another team, it helps your reactions.

GEORGE WONSLEY - "I wish I could have carried the ball more and break a few more longer runs. At this time of the year, I'm just trying to get used to carring the ball."
