NOTES

STEVE DeBERG completed 15 passes in a row at one point for a new Buc record. The old record was 12, also set by DeBerg at Detroit on 10/14/84. DeBerg's personal best was 18 straight while with Denver. He had 17 straight 12/12/82 and then one more on 12/19/82. At that time, the 18 in a row was a NFL record, since broken by Ken Anderson (20) on 1/2/83. DeBerg's TD pass to Jimmie Giles was the 99th TD pass of his career.

The touchdown reception by JIMMIE GILES was the 34th of his career, a Buc record.

DONALD IGWEBUIKE became the seventh Buc of all time to score 100 career points. He now has 101 His first FG attempt today hit the left upright and went through. Last week, he hit the right upright and missed, just as he did in the first game of 1985. His 53-yard attempt today would have matched his Buc record set last year had he made it. Five of his six kickoffs this year have been unreturnable from deep in the end zone.

RON HETLER did not open the second half today but did return to action after having been shaken up at the end of the first half. That ended a string in which Heller had played on every offensive snap all of last year and through the first game this year. He was the only Buc to play on every snap last year.

JAMES WILDER again had over 100 total yards from scrimmage as he did last week. This week, he finished 18 for 49 rushing and six for 73 receiving for 122 total yards from scrimmage. It was his 34th career game over 100 total yards and his second this season. He now has 253 total yards from scrimmage this year.

JERRY BURNS (The Heat) "The heat was a factor at the beginning, no question about it. I think our character showed up.

"The team played real well in the second half. The defense played very good. I didn't think our offense had arrived yet. Our timing was off just a little. We'll get better, I'll guarantee it."
