HEAD COACH BILL COWHER:

"I got a chance to bring back one of my old terms -- a nice, ugly win. We found a way to win but we certainly have left ourselves lots of room for improvement. We'll just go from there.

How much ugliness do you attribute to this time of year? "I don't know about the time of year. These are things that we have to get corrected. The penalties were things that we can correct. There's no reason for that. We had some opportunities and we just didn't take advantage of them. It's obviously a situation we need to look at and be very objective about it. From the same standpoint, I went into the locker room and thought we just lost 30-0. That's a good sign. The standards that we have set around here are very high and when you don't meet them, you feel a sense of dissatisfaction. I don't want them to lose that.

Does that make your decisions any more difficult? "There's no easy decision. You sit back and look at everything, take everything into account. You've got to make them and move on. We're certainly going to have to do that relative to certain positions where we have to name starters and make cuts. This is not an easy time of year. From the same standpoint we're about two weeks away from playing Jacksonville and that's basically our focus. These things have to get done.

<u>Do you still plan to name the starting quarterback this week?</u> "More than likely. I don't want to give you guys a time and date right now. But more than likely that will be done. I'll let you know.

Are you any closer to a decision than you were three weeks ago? "Yeah. I'm closer.

All three quarterbacks were lackluster tonight. Does that factor in to your decision? "We probably looked lackluster on offense. It was mentioned that we probably looked like a team that's been practicing with three quarterbacks. There were some good things. Erric (Pegram) and Jerome (Bettis) are running the ball awfully well. We had some guys make some plays. I thought we played well for the most part defensively against a team that runs the ball pretty well. There are some things that we have to work on and we have to get better at, but that's what this time of year is for.

How about Josh Miller, new punter? "I thought he did pretty good.

How about your kicker on kickoffs (Norm Johnson)? "I'd rather kick the ball down. I don't like the team starting from the 40 yard line. I'm not real happy about that.

Would you like to have your starting QB named by the time you start your next serious practice? "I haven't put a timetable on it. I would like to sit down and talk with all three quarterbacks before I make anything public and talk with our coaches, make a decision and go from there.

Mike Tomczak had the most opportunity to play tonight. Comment on his performance: "I thought offensively we kind of sputtered a little bit, not just because of Tomczak. We had some penalties. We had some guys running right free into the backfield at times. But then we did put together a very good drive at the end of the first half. There a very good defensive football team as well."

<u>P JOSH MILLER:</u> Assess your performance: "I had some good punts and a couple not so good. They gave me an opportunity tonight and all I can hope for is another opportunity next week.

Do you think you have the ability to punt in the NFL? "I don't want to sound big-headed because there's nothing for me to be big-headed about. But yes I can and if it's not here, hopefully somewhere else this season."

RB JEROME BETTIS: Does the offense need to know who its quarterback is now?
"Yeah, it's time. All three guys have their own abilities and strengths but we need to know who it's going to be so we can get one exhibition game with everybody knowing what's going to happen.

What about your role? Does it matter if you're not the starter? "Sure I want to carry the ball as much as possible and be the starter. But with me and Erric (Pegram) we have as good a one-two punch as you'll find. If they ask me to carry the ball 25 times, I will welcome it. But if not, that's okay too. We're going to be able to run the ball.

WR ANDRE HASTINGS: How was it in your first game back? "I think I'm pretty much ready. I need to take a few more hits, but I'm in the best physical shape I've ever been in and I'm ready to do whatever's asked of me.

Is it time to pick a quarterback? "Probably, but no matter who Coach Cowher picks, it's going to be tough decision. They've all looked good, and they've all struggled at times. We've got pretty much everything in line offensively except for that position. Plus we need to get Ernie (Mills) back. Heck, with our running game, we might not need to throw it.

<u>Would you like to return punts and kickoffs?</u> "I wouldn't mind it, but I don't know if the coaches will want me doing both, especially until Ernie comes back. I don't want to get winded and take away from the wide receiver position, but I'm ready to do it."

OT JAMAIN STEPHENS: Are the veterans working well with you? "Great. They're the best guys in the league I feel. I know this is the only place I've been but the attitude around here is win, win, win. That's exactly what they want to do."

OB MIKE TOMCZAK: Is anything more clear in your mind as to the quarterback position? "From my own personal opinion, I feel very confident. Obviously I didn't have a sound performance tonight. Offensively we really sputtered a great deal out there tonight but we finally, after 26 minutes, realized that in order for us to be a great football team, we have to put a long drive together. We got in the huddle and everyone communicated on the same page. Even though we had a few penalties down there right before we got in the endzone, we were able to overcome that adversity and put the ball in the endzone right before the half.

When do you expect a decision from Coach Cowher? "I don't know. I think he has a certain timetable. He knows in his mind when a decision is going to come and I'll just wait anxiously for that time.

If you had to handicap it, what would you put your odds at? "We're not allowed to handicap things in the National Football League. It's illegal."

OB JIM MILLER: Do you think Coach Cowher is going to name a starter before the next preseason game? "I hope he does. I think they'd want a starter to be in against Philadelphia to get some continuity and get a feel for everything. But that's his decision. Whatever he decides, all three of us have to accept it and work with it. Either way, whether it's Kordell (Stewart), Mike (Tomczak) or myself, we're going to win a lot of football games. We've got a good team and yeah, we've still got some corrections to make, but we'll be fine no matter who he chooses.

Do you think you played well enough to win the job? "I don't see why not. I don't know what I've done wrong. But again, it's just who he feels comfortable with, who he thinks is going to be productive, who's going to lead the team and who's going to move the team. There are a lot of different scenarios. Mike, myself and Kordell all bring something different to the table. That's up to Coach Cowher to decide which way he wants to go with it."

OB KORDELL STEWART: After tonight's performance do you feel better or worse about your chances? "I'm just out there pretty much just doing what I can. I had opportunities going against Green Bay. I felt I did well. I went out there tonight and we had a nice drive. We had a few errors as far as not completing passes, but considering the circumstances, in my opinion I think I did well. But it's all about how the coaches critique you. We have our own way and they have their own way of judging things. There were a few things that I did well and a few things that I didn't do so well. At the same time, I feel confident.

You're the crowd favorite: "It's nice to know I have the crowd behind me."

HEAD COACH TONY DUNGY:

I'm just a little bit disappointed because the first two weeks I thought we played better each week. We really didn't play that well today, but we are playing against a very good football team. We had our chances in the first half and didn't take advantage of them. It's tough to go on the road against a playoff type team and blow opportunities like that. I'm a little disappointed with the penalties and not really being sharp. Overall, we just weren't real crisp. That will come. Our effort was good. Our hitting was good. We just need to clean a few things up (mistakes). Pittsburgh's defense played pretty well. They do a lot of things that you have to take more than a day to prepare for. They blitz a lot and they are a very physical unit. We had our chances. I thought we moved the ball well early. Unfortunately, a sack killed one drive and a penalty on our punt return. This is not the type of defense that's you're not going to get many opportunities. Those are the type of plays we need to win this type of game. I thought our defense played okay. They (Pittsburgh) took advantage of the opportunities and we didn't. Our young guys played well tonight. Unfortunately, they just didn't click consistently. We need to be sharper. I hate to see the mistakes and the errors. You have to be sharper than that when you're trying to beat a good team.

(On his emotions coming back to Three Rivers) I really wasn't very emotional. I had a fun time here seeing many friends and Mr. Rooney especially. I was really more excited about how we would respond to this test. Unfortunately, we didn't play as well as I hoped we would. My emotions are a little disappointed right now.

LB HARDY NICKERSON:

(On playing in Pittsburgh) It was a slow evening. We came out and played well early. There was a string of plays late in the first half which they were able to put together a drive. We've got to get better. We'll get better. Fortunately, this is a preseason game but we want to step it up to another level so that we're able to play with a team like Pittsburgh, toe-to-toe, four quarters, and come out with a victory.

(On forcing turnovers) We've been working on stripping the ball in practice, trying to create turnovers, but it just hasn't happened. A guy may be getting his hand on the ball, and it's slipping out of his hand. But we'll keep working hard. Turnovers come in bunches. Once they start, hopefully they'll continue the whole season. We just have to continue to work hard, getting our jobs done, concentrating on our assignments, no mental mistakes, and not beating ourselves. If we do that, we'll be okay.

(On defensive blitzing) We have a versatile group especially at linebacker. I'm sure the coaches want to make sure that we mix things up and give people different looks and keep them off balance. It's all part of playing defense. Pittsburgh does the same thing. They blitz a lot of people, and send different blitzes at people to keep them off balance. If you get an offense to play off balance, they kind of play right into your hands. That's something we've been concentrating on and we're pretty good at it.

FB TRACY JOHNSON:

(On the team's performance) I do have to give their team a lot of credit. They are the defending AFC Champions, and they are a good squad. As far as our performance, I still think that a lot of it is due to the fact that we weren't able to practice and see a lot of the 3-4 defense. We did see it on film, but like with Miami we'll have to go back and watch their previous game and prepare better for that team and other teams that we might face.

OB TRENT DILFER:

(Evaluating the game) I think my impressions of the game, are that like I said in the first two preseason games, when you're able to run the football and dominate the line of scrimmage it makes everything a lot easier. Those 3rd and 4s and 3rd and 5s are a lot easier than 3rd and 10, and 3rd and 11. I think the problems that we ran into today, and these aren't excuses, obviously they outplayed us, but when you have to prepare for a 3-4 defense, it's nice to have 2, 3, or 4 days to prepare for them and be comfortable with it. But when you have a day and a half and only one of those are in pads, it's more difficult to prepare for the run-throughs and the blitzes. The positives of the first half were that we were able to get out of the hole. When we got backed up, we got out of the hole. Sometimes you win games doing that. You battle for field position and get a big play, and you can score some points. I wasn't really disappointed with our performance in the first half, because we were able to do that. We were able to establish field position for the defense. They did a good job of holding them with the exception of the one drive. I think what I was most disappointed with was our ability on 3rd down. I take a good deal of responsibility of that, because twice they just tricked me. They brought blitzes that one—I just hadn't prepared for and couldn't get the ball off, and the other one was one that I didn't see. I looked for it, and I didn't see it. It cost us a 3rd and

8. It's one of those games that you look at the film, you see why you weren't to play well, and then you answer those questions. You go out and prepare next week better in those areas. I think it was more us not executing and when you play teams with pro bowlers, Super Bowl teams, you can't make mistakes, and we made too many mental mistakes. They didn't result in fumbles or interceptions, but they resulted in penalties and the inability to convert on 3rd and long.

(On only scoring two touchdowns in three preseason games) I think we're concerned with how we performed in the red zone in the first two preseason games. We shot ourselves in the foot a couple times, but in this game, it's tough to go 80 yards against the Pittsburgh Steelers, and you're not going to do it many times. You might do it in a course of an entire game twice. We didn't do it at all in the first half. That doesn't mean we couldn't have done it in the second half if the first group was in there. I'm concerned with our ability in the first three games of not getting in the end zone. A lot of the teams in this league have problems in the red zone for a period of time, but figure it out and score a lot of touchdowns. I think we'll be able to do that with how well we usually run the football.
