Referee Dick Jorgensen (on the penalty which erased St. Louis' field goal): "The blocking back for St. Louis, number 59, was called for a personal foul. He blocked forward, then kicked his leg backwards into the defender who was going by him which is kicking the opponent."

ST. LOUIS COACH JIM HANIFAN: "It was an even-steven game. I thought we had the momentum in the third quarter. We decided to keep it on the ground.
