NOTES: The 35 points by the Buccaneers was the second highest in team history. The record is 37 points (37-3) against Green Bay 11/22/81. It was the third time in team history the Bucs have scored five TDs which is a team record.

This is the first time the Bucs have had back to back wins since the end of the 1982 season when they won the last three games of that season.

Tommy Kramer's 386 passing yards is the first 300-plus game since Danny White in the sixth game of 1983 against the Bucs (10/9/83). Second time Kramer has thrown for 300-plus against Tampa Bay. The third time a Viking quarterback has done it. 386 yards is the second best ever against the Bucs with Lynn Dickey throwing for 418 10/12/80 (OT).

James Wilder combined for more than 100 yards for the fifth time in six games this year and nine of his last 11 while playing tailback. He now has 1,944 career rushing yards. Wilder had 89 rushing and 40 receiving for a total of 129 yards. He now has 888 yards from scrimmage and led the NFL in that category going into the game.

Tampa Bay's five takeaways gives them nine in the last two games after having only two in the first four weeks.

Kevin House had 100-plus yards receiving for the first time this season and the ninth time in his career. He finished Today's game with seven for 126 yards.

MORE NOTES

After Lee Roy Selmon had sacked opposing quarterbacks three times causing fumbles and David Logan recovering all three, the two switched roles today with Logan sacking Kramer and causing a fumble recovered by Selmon for the first time. Selmon now has $73\frac{1}{2}$ career sacks, 25 career caused fumbles and 10 fumble recoveries with one sack, two recoveries and one fumble caused in today's game.

QUOTES MINNESOTA PLAYERS

TOMMY KRAMER 'We felt we could throw the ball as long as our line did the job. When they're creating turnovers that's the same thing as stopping you. On the first two KNAMANNEX times we had the ball that's the best we've executed in a long time. Then we started getting penalties and turnovers and that hurt us. We didn't let down at all. We did a lot of things offensively that prevented us from winning. We felt we were capable of winning this game. Hugh Green is a great player and I'm sure they would have been better with him in."

SAMMY WHITE 'The offensive coach tries to instill in a quarterback, take what they give you. They have very good people back there (cornerbacks). They were also blitzing a lot. Tommy (Kramer) had to make som pretty good moved to get away. Deep zones are alright, but ypu really like playing against a team that's blitzing. No matter how great shape you're in when you're out there in that humidity it really takes its toll."

TED BROWN ''That (stats) shows the game is not built on stats alone. After penalties you really try to stay calm and cool and try to come back and not make the same mistakes you made before. (ON WILDER) ''I think he ran advant as hard as any back I've ever seen run. He is probably a much tougher ball player this year. It takes a man to grind out the short ones.''

MIKE JONES 'They held their own (T.B. DEFENSE). I thought that we were real prepared for them. This game shows that we are ready to score again. We have to keep scoring and piling them on. We didn't score any TDs in our last two games. This is not a one man show it takes ll on offense and defense to win in this league. We started out like fires in a forest. It's tough on a quarterback like Kramer but he just has to bounce right back.
