POST-GAME NOTES & QUOTES

Tampa Bay vs. St. Louis
October 16, 1983

NEAL O'DONOGHUE's 52-yard field goal was a personal and club best. Two previous Cardinal kickers had booted 51-yarders, Jim Baaken vs. Cleveland in 1964 and Steve Little vs. Dallas in 1979.

The previous long regular season field goal of O'Donoghue's career was a 49-yarder for Tampa Bay at Detroit in 1978. He was 0-for-9 lifetime on 50-yard or longer attempts prior to his kick today. His longest field goal on this field was a 47-yarder vs. New Orleans in 1978.

TAMPA BAY COACH JOHN MCKAY: "We were beaten by the St. Louis Cardinals. It is all that simple."

(Thompson's last interception): "I made a terrible call. Why go deep? We are in the ball game."

(4th and five): "They felt they had a pass that would do it. Wilder did break wide open. Baker tipped the ball. That didn't hurt us. We got the ball right back.

(lack of linebackers): "We have serious problems. We couldn't play Hugh Green very long."

(Cardinals running): "We had to make adjustments because of the outside people. When you make adjustments on a sound defense, you normally get hurt. Give the Cardinals credit, they did a good job."

(the outlook?): "Bleak."

NOTES: Jeff Davis finished the game with 18 combined tackles. The defensive stats should read 16 tackles, two assists. That is a new individual Buccaneer regular season record, equaling Richard Wood's 18 tackles in the 1979 NFC Championship Game (1/6/80) vs. Los Angeles. The previous mark was 16 tackles, achieved four times by three different players.

ST. LOUIS COACH JIM HANIFAN: "We've gone through such adversity and had so much misfortune. This week we told the players let's play with confidence, play aggressively and let's get out there and have some fun playing. The players got their rear-ends chewed out last week and we told them Wednesday - let's start a whole new thing."

"You have to give Tampa Bay credit. They hung in there. I think it's a great tribute to Coach McKay and his staff and players."

"A big play was when Neal O'Donoghue stopped that last kickoff. He might have taken it into the end zone. It was a heckuva play. The big Irishman did a heckuva job. I don't know about those Irish kids."
