POST-GAME QUOTES

CHICAGO COACH NEILL ARMSTRONG: (Asked if the Bucs should win the NFC Central are they the best team in the division to represent it) It's not my job to evaluate the teams. The team that goes there is the team that deserves to be there.

I think Walter Payton will be all right next week. He just had a slight head injury.

The defense played the most fantastic game I've seen in a long time. We were using the zone a great deal today especially when the Bucs went with two tight ends. I thought we defensed that very well. We didn't blitz as much as we thought we would have to. We had good pressure and we sacked Williams several times (twice) and had several near sacks. The defense did a good job.

We sat on the ball a lot more than we'd planned. The game wasn't as I had envisioned

TAMPA BAY COACH JOHN McKAY: We just played lousy, that's all there is to it. A total collapse of a football team. Chicago just seemed to want it more than us.

Our special teams the last two weeks have just been horrible. I don't know why, before that they were fairly good. We just could not punt today.

Our offensive line took the day off. Tampa Bay has clinched nothing. If we play like this we have no way in the world of winning this division, not one iota. You're not even amateur to let someone block a punt like that. That's a joke.

When things go bad they really go bad. We were running around out there like chickens with our heads cut off. It was a sandlot game.

(On what went wrong on the blocked punt). Our guys are not bashful, they just come out and say who made the mistake. The guy slipped and still blocked it.

(Why was Williams taken out): We knew we really had to pass, why get him banged up. Williams did not have a good game and it will not suffice to give 10,000 reasons why.

I'm just sorry the governor wasn't here to see it.

NOTES: The last time the Bucs were shutout was almost exactly two years ago on December 4, 1977 by these same Chicago Bears, 10-0. That was 32 games ago. It was the Bucs' 26th consecutive defeat and the following weeks they defeated New Orleans for their first victory. Since that game the Bucs have a record of 16-16 counting today.

This was the first time in the 22 games that Doug Williams was the primary quarterback (and in the 24 games he has started) that the Bucs did not score a touchdown.

With 4 receptions today Isaac Hagins now has 36 on the season, the most ever by a Buc in one year.

Terry Schmidt and Gary Fencik now have six interceptions each this season. It was the first time Williams has ever had four passes intercepted in one game and the first time the Bucs have ever had five picked off in one game. The Bucs' (Gary Huff) had four intercepted at Seattle on 10/16/77.

This was the Bucs best defensive performance ever in terms of fewest yards allowed with 164 surrendered. The previous best was 173 to Green Bay on 12/3/78. The 17 yards allowed in passing is one yard better than the total of 18 acheived by the New York Giants on 10/7/79. The 10 first downs are the fewest first downs the Bucs have ever allowed.
