MINNESOTA COACH BUD GRANT: "You go into a game with a plan you hope will work. The Bucs showed their offense in the first half and we made the proper adjustments in the second half to get the win. The coaches didn't make the changes, the players did. They got a better reading on what the Bucs were doing. I would call it a complete turnaround in the second half.

"I don't think there was an advantage for the Buccaneers playing in the hot weather. I think we were even in better shape in the second half than the Bucs.

"Tommy Kramer played a great game."

TAMPA BAY COACH JOHN MCKAY: "We played very poorly in the second half."

"I have no answers. We played very, very poorly. I think our defense played well enough to win but the offense had nothing going for it in the second half at all.

(10 points enough?). No, we kept trying to score. But if you fumble and do things like that you can't and win games.

(long pass on third and one?) Well it's a bad call now. We were ahead 10-0 and we thought that if we hit the thing. Gordie was covered but the back coming out of the backfield was uncovered and he just didn't see him. Had we completed it, it would have been a fantastic call.

We will go on to Detroit and play for some pride.

(Asked about several different plays

We just did not score enough points. We are our own worst enemy. We had a good drive going and I thought we would take the lead and we just blew it. I don't know who I can blame that on since all of the players played lovely. That's the way it goes.

I'm not going to go out and cut my throat. There were other teams that they probably eliminated.

(most discouraging of year?) Yes, definitely because I thought we had an excellent chance to win. I thought we could play with Minnesota, I still think we can but we let them off the hook. More credit to them and that's it.

I'm not going to talk about individuals. I get in trouble there.

(asked if he could say if he would go with Fusina in the last two games?) Absolutely not. If we're blaming the loss on Doug Williams then we are all in trouble. No more experimentation, we had enough experimentation out there today.

(losing leads) It shouldn't happen but it has. We played just about everybody and as I said everybody played lovely.

I thought we put good pressure on Kramer. He's a good quarterback and scrambled at times and made a couple scramble passes. I don't think the defense beat us. The defense made a terrible error at the end (Brown's long run) but that was more out of anxiety to make something happen. But throughout most of the game they played pretty well.

NFC PLAYOFF PICTURE: Minnesota's win today has eliminated three teams from the NFC Central Division title chase. Green Bay, Tampa Bay and Chicago (if Chicago maintains its lead over Green Bay) are now all eliminated. Chicago (6-8 after today's win over Green Bay) could still tie either Minnesota or Minnesota and Detroit with an 8-8 record but cannot win a tiebreaker with the Vikings. In a two-way tie, Chicago's two losses to the Vikings eliminates them and in a three-way tie Chicago's 2-2 record in games between the three teams compared to Minnesota's 3-1 record eliminates them.
