COACHES COMMENTS

TAMPA BAY COACH JOHN MCKAY: We are division champions and proud of the team. We didn't want them to win on our mistakes. We played a very cautious and cool game. Bell ran well, go talk to the players, they're the champs.

DOUG WILLIAMS: The quarterback running wasn't in the game plan. They have such a great pursuing team that I told Coach McKay we should fake some of the runs and just keep the football.

I don't think I did that much to be worried about being changed to running back. Kansas City had great pursuit in going with the flow so everything was wide open

BUC OWNER HUGH CULVERHOUSE: We're a little ahead of schedule the way I figured. We thought we could do it in five years to be a competitive ballclub. There are a lot of breaks in this game, sometimes you win the ones you don't expect to and lose the ones you think you'll win.

The fact that the coaches were willing to go with the young players, the inexperienced players made this possible. I think we've laid the foundation for what I think will be a continued successful franchise. Without reservation John McKay should be Coach of the Year, he's my coach of the year anyway.

I would like to vote our fans the fans of the year, I think they've been the fans of the last four years.
