Field Judge Armen Terzian on the pass to Jimmie Giles in the first half for a possible touchdown: "I ruled the ball was moving across the chest of the receiver as he went out of bounds. I felt he did not have complete control of the ball."

TAMPA BAY COACH JOHN McKAY: I think we outplayed them, I think Philadelphia played well. We got penalized so often on our offense and that slowed us down, but I thought we could move the ball on Philadelphia and we did. I didn't think they could run on us and that the only chance they had was to throw the football and they did that fairly well.

We intended to hit them (the Philadelphia running backs) pretty good if they caught it but I couldn't say that (that being "Tampa Bay's defense intimidated their running backs as receivers). You know Eckwood couldn't hold onto one that gave them a touchdown.

I can't comment on the touchdown pass to Giles. I haven't seen a replay. He thought he had it, I guess the official ruled he did not.

I'm not really trying to prove that I can coach a football team. We have good players, we have a fairly young team. We really got hurt today offensively with Carlton not being able to perform and we had to take Horton out. We're a good solid football team, and I think we can play most anybody. I think today we just played better than Philadelphia.

I don't know about Hannah, I would hope so (that he can play next week).

THE FIRST DRIVE - It's very important in any game if you can do that. It's what you've worked on and when you're successful they have a little bit more faith in your plan. We put in the sprint pass and it worked for a touchdown and a couple of good first downs but basically it was the same plays Bell has been running all year.

WILLIAMS He proved what I've been saying, I think he's one of the best young quarterbacks in football. He has had a bad game or two but he's had some excellent games. I think his performance today was excellent. He had one dropped by Ike. He threw a bad ball to Eckwood in my opinion but Eckwood could have caught it but otherwise he was excellent.

We took the ball so long on the first drive and it's hard to use Carmichael when he's sitting over there. We doubled him at times but let's face it he caught a touchdown pass. He's a big receiver, I don't think I could miss him either. I wouldn't wnat to throw to some of the guys we've got, 5-foot nine and one quarter.

PHILADELPHIA COACH DICK VERMEIL: Their execution in the first quarter ... the first half ... was just super. We just missed too many tackles and dropped too many balls.

This is not an expansion team. It is a pro football team, a conference championship football team that won 10 games. They beat the Los Angeles Rams when they were healthy. They were definitely the better football team, today.

The credit goes to John McKay and his staff and his players. There was no question about who was the best football team today, the game wasn't as close as the final score.

RUNNING BACK RICKY BELL (Bell's 38 carries is a new NFL record for most rushes in post-season play. The old mark was 37 carries by Lawrence McCutcheon in 1975 for Los Angeles against St.Louis. McCutcheon gained 202 yards in that game. Bell has carried 77 times in the last two games (he rushed 39 times in the final season game against Kansas City)).

Quotes from Bell: "Of course we played a weaker schedule than Philadelphia and they have more experience. They were in the playoffs last year. But it really doesn't matter. When you put those eleven men on the field, it is who makes the less mistakes and I think we took advantage of the opportunities this week like the fumble on the four-yard line.

We just played a sound game and we didn't make many mistakes and that was the reason we were on top at the end.

I don't care if I carry the ball 10 times as long as we win. Whatever it takes, it really doesn't matter to me.

It wasn't really in the game plan for me to carry the ball that much.
